ATTENTION ALL EXHIBITORS:

At the Show, unlike in a paddock, animal movement is restricted and the animals can't go and find their own shade/water.

As the Show is held in summer, it is recommended that you bring shade and suitable water containers for your animals.

Where applicable, a ground levy of \$7.00 per animal, to a maximum of \$20.00, must be included with entry forms.

Tuberculosis Testing

- 1) **ALL LIVESTOCK: Must Have a TB Animal Status Declaration Card (including calf club animals). A copy of the Declaration must accompany entry forms and the ORIGINAL must be brought with you to the Show as they will be inspected in the unloading area. This is a legal requirement for all animals being moved.**
- 2) All cattle entered for showing must be accompanied in transit by a signed and dated TB Animal Status Declaration Card, showing a TB Clear Status in accordance with present legislation.
- 3) All exhibitors must sign the declaration on the official entry form.
- 4) Animals being moved to a show MUST HAVE the Official NAIT location identity number included on entry forms and the animals MUST HAVE the WHITE, NAIT approved RFID ear tag Identification.
- 5) **NORTHLAND LIVESTOCK:** For animals from Northland [C10 status herds in Surveillance Areas] NO test is required but a clearly dated test allocation form or other documentation from the Animal Health Board must be submitted that shows the herd is not overdue for a whole herd test.
- 6) **ALL AREAS OTHER THAN NORTHLAND:** For animals from all other herds and areas -
 - If the herd has a C3 status or better, no test is required PROVIDED the last whole herd test was within 12 months prior to the show.
 - If the last whole herd test was not within 12 months of the show, then show cattle over one year old MUST have a clear test within 60 DAYS of the show.

- If the herd has a status of C1 or C2, then show cattle over one year old MUST have a clear test within 60 DAYS of the show.
- This certificate showing individual animal identification numbers and current status MUST accompany completed entry forms or the entry will not be able to be accepted by the Secretary.

Dairy Goats

Starting 9.30am

Please see the conditions of entry in the front of this schedule and this section.

CONDITIONS:

- Goats to be penned by 8.30 am. Bring your own shade.
- All goats must be tied in designated areas.
- Does in milk will NOT be penalised if it necessary to ease the udder before judging. Does may not be stripped out in the ring.
- All dairy goats (with the exception of pet goats entered in the pet ring) must be registered and recorded with the NZDGBA at the time of entry and the registration number must be recorded on the entry form.
- The by-laws of the RAS of NZ for the exhibition of dairy goats shall apply at this Show.
- In all classes throughout the schedule, the full prize money will be paid out if there are four or more entries. Where the Prize Money is 1st = \$30, 2nd = \$20, 3rd = 10 if there are three entries or less, prize money will be scaled as follows:
1 entry 1st \$10
2 entries 1st, 2nd \$15, \$10
3 entries 1st, 2nd, 3rd \$15, \$10, \$5
4 entries 1st, 2nd, 3rd \$30, \$20, \$10
- If applicable, sponsored prize money of a section or class may be paid in lieu of Society prize money and will not be additional. Sponsorships are subject to confirmation.

- Class 712** **Herd Register Type & Production**
To be judged in accordance with NZDGBA rules. Details of Herd Test Production to be supplied with entry or given to steward on the day.
- Class 713** **Associate Records Type & Production**
Rules as per the previous class.
- Class 714** **Herd Register Best Udder**
Open to all Does that have born a kid.
- Class 715** **Associate Record Best Udder**
Open to all Does that have born a kid.
- Class 716** **Local Best Udder**
Open to local does that have born a kid
- Class 717** **Junior Showmanship**
Open to 15 years & under
- Class 718** **Junior Herdsperson**
