ATTENTION ALL EXHIBITORS:

At the Show, unlike in a paddock, animal movement is restricted and the animals can't go and find their own shade/water.

As the Show is held in summer, it is recommended that you bring shade and suitable water containers for your animals.

Tuberculosis Testing

- 1) **ALL LIVESTOCK: Must Have a TB Animal Status Declaration Card (including calf club animals). A copy of the Declaration must accompany entry forms and the ORIGINAL must be brought with you to the Show as they will be inspected in the unloading area. This is a legal requirement for all animals being moved.**
- 2) All cattle entered for showing must be accompanied in transit by a signed and dated TB Animal Status Declaration Card, showing a TB Clear Status in accordance with present legislation.
- 3) All exhibitors must sign the declaration on the official entry form.
- 4) Animals being moved to a show **MUST HAVE** the Official NAIT location identity number included on entry forms and the animals **MUST HAVE** the WHITE, NAIT approved RFID ear tag Identification.
- 5) **NORTHLAND LIVESTOCK:** For animals from Northland [C10 status herds in Surveillance Areas] NO test is required but a clearly dated test allocation form or other documentation from the Animal Health Board must be submitted that shows the herd is not overdue for a whole herd test.
- 6) **ALL AREAS OTHER THAN NORTHLAND:** For animals from all other herds and areas -
 - If the herd has a C3 status or better, no test is required PROVIDED the last whole herd test was within 12 months prior to the show.
 - If the last whole herd test was not within 12 months of the show, then show cattle over one year old **MUST** have a clear test within 60 DAYS of the show.

- If the herd has a status of C1 or C2, then show cattle over one year old **MUST** have a clear test within 60 DAYS of the show.
- This certificate showing individual animal identification numbers and current status **MUST** accompany completed entry forms or the entry will not be able to be accepted by the Secretary.

CONDITIONS:

- Sheep to be penned by 10.00 am
- If sufficient numbers of a particular breed are entered, consideration will be given to allowing that breed to have their own breed ring.
- The age of sheep must date from the end of the third week after lambing commences.
- It will be an instruction to the Judge that no award be made unless the exhibit is true to type.
- Shearing Dates: All sheep in shorn classes to be shorn since 20 July, except in lamb classes which are optional & Black & Coloured sheep after 20th May.
- Exhibitors are referred to Rules re Sheep, and to notes on entry form.
- Declaration of Shorn Sheep Classes in all breeds, must be filled in on entry form and name of breeder must be shown where not bred by exhibitor.
- No sheep is eligible to compete in more than one class in its section
- An Ovine Brucellosis Accreditation Certificate **MUST** be presented with all Ram entries.
- The Sheep Section is open to Registered and Unregistered animals. However, please note that in the event of the Champion of the Breed being unregistered, that Champion will not be eligible for the Supreme Champion Sheep of the Show.
- The Points System for Most Points awards is: 1st = 6; 2nd = 4; 3rd = 2; 4th = 1
- In all classes throughout the schedule, the full prize money will be paid out if there are four or more entries. Where the Prize Money is 1st = \$30, 2nd = \$20, 3rd = 10 (e.g. Sheep Classes) if there are three entries or less, prize money will be scaled as follows:
 - 1 entry 1st \$10
 - 2 entries 1st, 2nd \$15, \$10
 - 3 entries 1st, 2nd, 3rd \$15, \$10, \$5
 - 4 entries 1st, 2nd, 3rd \$30, \$20, \$10
- If applicable, sponsored prize money of a section or class may be paid in lieu of Society prize money and will not be additional. Sponsorships are subject to confirmation.
